

SHOOTING - MOROCCO - BARBARY PARTRIDGE



DAY BY DAY FROM MARRAKECH

OBTSH02BP Validity: **End September to End December.** Minimum 4 shooters.

Prices will be based on 2 persons sharing accommodation.

Your programme includes:

* 1 day's shooting in a private reserve. * Shooting Rights and formalities re Temporary introduction & extraction of firearms in Morocco.
* 1 night's accommodation in the Hunting Lodge (full board). * Private transfers to & from Reserves. * Guides & porters (tips not included). * Taxes on bagged birds in accordance with authorised amounts. * All relevant Moroccan duties, insurances & taxes.

3 twinned private reserves of 30,000 hectares in the heart of the Western High Atlas Mountains some 85km from Marrakech at an altitude varying between 1,000 & 2,100 metres.

Varied countryside: mountainous for sport shooting, little hills for an easier shoot. Rocky relief, woods of juniper, Holm-oak and Barbary fig alternating with esparto grasses and terraced plots.

This wild game fowl, 'Perdrix Gamba' or 'Alectoris Barbara', averages here between 32-34cm. and 46-49cm; and between 700 to 800gr.
Average shoot is of 8 to 10 birds. **There is no Bag Tax for up to 10 partridges per person per day.** There are also mountain hares to keep you alert.

DAY 1: 07:30 departure in chauffeured ATV from your hotel or riad. After around 1½ hours en route, we meet up with our shooting guide and porters. Alighting from the vehicle, we set out by foot, or on mule back, to the hunting terrain. Distribution of purchased boxed shells. Shooting of driven birds on the rise, with or without dogs. This wild fowl normally scatters rapidly in groups of 8 to 15 and we shoot from small lines of 2 to 4 guns.

We take a break for our field picnic (salad, char-grilled meat, cheese, fruit, water, wine, tea). In the late afternoon, we continue up to the Hunting Lodge at 2,100 metres, with a large lounge with chimney place, 6 rooms each with 3 beds, shower, WC, satellite TV, cooks for our dinner and accommodation in the Hunting Lodge for the night.

DAY 2: After breakfast, return to your hotel or riad in Marrakech or take another day's pre-reserved shooting at a different location.....?

Plus obligatory per person One-time Temporary Shooting Permit; Permit to carry arms; Moroccan Formalities for Temporary Gun Entry Permits, Insurances: **Approx €150**

The importation of shells is prohibited. Shells by box will be sold on site in accordance with the calibre of gun advised through the Permit Form you've sent. The on-site service of cleaning, freezing and packing of the birds is offered, as is that of a cooler should you not bring your own, and an Export Permit of the bag(s) can be arranged, all for an additional fee, paid on site.
